Lifeguard

Ages 15 and up. Starting at \$11.00/hour

Lifeguards, under the supervision of a Lesson Manager or Head Guard, provide supervision and safety at the aquatic facilities. Must be able to clearly communicate, as well as understand both verbal and written instructions.

Swim Instructor

Age 15 and up. Starting at \$11.00/hour

Swim instructors provide instruction for the District's swim lesson program (infant through adult) under the supervision of a Lesson Manager. Must be able to clearly communicate, as well as understand both verbal and written instructions. Performs a variety of duties and other work as required.

Aquatics Programs staff members work at one of two District Aquatics facilities. Programs are held 7 days/week in the summer, from early morning into the evening. Most staff will work an average of 15-20 hours per week. Mandatory training is held every Friday morning in the summer.

Lifeguard and Swim Instructor Positions require certification in American Red Cross (ARC) Lifeguard Training, including CPR/AED for Lifeguards and First Aid, and Administering Emergency Oxygen.
