<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>\$300,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Senior Center Building</b> <i>The new 22,587 square foot Senior Center will serve as a meeting place for classes, lectures and fitness activities. It will feature a 1,630 square foot dining room as well as a reception hall for special events. Presently, more than 2,000 guests visit the Senior Center weekly for programs, classes, events and activities.</i></li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>\$50,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Computer Lab</b> <i>This 645 square foot lab will offer 20 individual computer stations for professional and personal skill-building, job searches or just plain having fun. The room will be located in the interior space of the Senior Center, near the game and arts &amp; crafts rooms.</i></li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>\$35,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Entry Lobby -- FUNDED</b> <i>Modern, open and flooded with natural light, The 1,140 square foot entry lobby will welcome visitors to the new Senior Center.</i></li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>\$100,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Multi-Purpose Room -- FUNDED</b> <i>Seating up to 250 guests, this 4,116 square foot, octagon-shaped room with open-beam ceilings will serve as the venue for wedding receptions and senior events. Floor to ceiling glass and doors along the east side of the multi-purpose room will open onto the park. The Senior Center hosts 15 to 20 special events annually.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Dance Studio</b> <i>A 2,068 square foot studio with a wall of windows and doors facing the park, and two walls with ballet barres and mirrors from floor to ceiling to enhance dance and fitness classes.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Coffee Lounge -- FUNDED</b> <i>Located off the main hallway, the coffee lounge will provide another meeting place to relax and socialize over a cup of coffee or tea. Ninety five percent of the visitors to the new Senior Center will pass by this 255 square foot lounge. If you're meeting a friend, you're bound to spot them from here.</i></li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>75,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Lounge Library</b> <i>With a three-sided fireplace, a flat screen television, a window seat, and an at-home, comfortable feeling, this 1,066 square foot space is Senior Center Supervisor Kendra Luke's favorite room in the new facility.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Dining Room</b> <i>Twice the size of the former Senior Center dining room, this 1,630 square foot space seats 90 in a setting designed to give the feel that one is dining out with friends. The CC Café will serve nutritious meals here that for some, is perhaps their sole nutritious meal of their day, along with their only opportunity to socialize.</i></li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>\$25,000</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Courtyard</b> <i>This space will be an outdoor retreat from activities inside the new center, offering a quiet spot in the shade to relax and enjoy a moment of calm.</i></li> <li>• <b>Outdoor Patio</b> <i>This patio will be located on the park side of the new Senior Center, and will be accessible from the dining room for visitors who want a quick, refreshing break out of doors.</i></li> </ul>

**\$25,000 (cont.)**

**• Kitchen**

*This full equipped, state-of-the-art, 1,257 square foot commercial kitchen has been designed with every amenity. It will be used for center activities ranging from Friday Chef's Lunches and pancake breakfasts to special events, and will be available to rent. Amenities will include a walk-in freezer/refrigerator, washing station, coffee and beverage station, serving counter with rollup window, a grill and prep stations. Many happy occasions for years to come will begin right here in this kitchen.*

**\$20,000**

**• Senior Center Pathway**

*This path winds approximately 300 feet from Gregory lane to the Senior Center's front entrance. Landscaped on each side, this special space will be the first point at which one might run into a friend or two.*

**\$15,000**

**• Bocce Court**

*This is one of the most popular and heavily used sports areas in the entire complex. If you've never played bocce ball, this is a great place to try it.*

**\$10,000**

**• Arts & Crafts Room -- FUNDED**

*This 571 square foot room will be the meeting place for arts and crafts classes. It is where many of the creations for sale in various boutiques sponsored by the Senior Center will be knit, crocheted, sewn and painted.*

**• Game Room**

*This 507 square foot space faces the center's courtyard, bringing the outside in. A great deal of pleasure and fun will be happening in this room.*

**• Seating Area**

*This octagon-shaped area is the central space outside of the classrooms, and was designed to encourage visitors to socialize.*

**• Horseshoe Pit**

*We don't use horseshoes for much of anything nowadays, but they are front and center in the popular Horseshoe Pit. Dating back to a time when ranch hands first pitched horseshoes for fun, the competition can get fierce, but it's always good-natured and lots of fun.*

**\$5,000**

**• Multi-Purpose Room Stage**

*This 200 square foot stage will host the array of theatrical and musical productions that attract so many visitors to The Senior Center throughout the year. You never know, it may also be host to a newborn star.*

**• Café Kitchen**

*The highly visible cafe kitchen will serve the dining area. It also presents a great opportunity to honor a beloved chef in the family.*

**• Entry Path Bench (\$5,000 each)**

*Two to three benches will line the path meandering from Gregory Lane to the Senior Center's front entrance. This area will be landscaped to give the feel of an idyllic place to sit and spend a few minutes with friends in the sun.*

**• Coffee Bar**

*Despite its small scale, the self-serve coffee bar located inside the multi-purpose room will host hundreds of visitors to the center each week.*
