AB1234 Training: Two-hour ethics training required under state law (AB1234). This training will be provided by the District's General Counsel, Osa Wolff. Topics will include laws governing conflicts of interest, government transparency, public records, open meetings, and fair process. The training will also cover rules for electronic communication and guidelines for professionalism. The training will provide a review of Form 700s, the Fair Political Practices Act, Government Code 1090 and other conflict of interest avoidance rules.
