Re: 2021 Special Events

BACKGROUND

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the District special events team had to halt all of our traditional community events, beginning with the Egg Hunt in April of 2020. In the 14 months since then we were able to hold a virtual Tinkers & Thinkers event and some socially distant drive-through events in October 2020 around Halloween and another with the spring bunny in April of 2021. Plans for a similar holiday event in December of 2020 were made and then subsequently struck, following a new stay-at-home order from the state. Staff is now in the process of planning some in-person events in anticipation of loosening restrictions.
