

AQUATICS 2021 SUMMER JOBS



Lifeguard - Ages 15 and up. Starting at \$14.07/hour

Lifeguard - under the supervision of a Lesson Manager or Head Guard, provide supervision and safety at the District's aquatic facilities.

Swim Instructor - Ages 15 and up. Starting at \$14.07/hour

Swim instructors provide instruction for the District's swim lesson program (infant through adult) under the supervision of a Lesson Manager. Swim team experience is helpful, but not required. Training is provided.

Swim Coach - Ages 15 and up. \$14.07 - \$19.90/hour, based on experience

Coach daily practices and swim meets for the Dolphins Swim Team (April-July), under supervision of the Head Coach. Swim team experience preferred.

Schedule & Job Requirements:

Aquatics Staff members work at the District Aquatics facilities. Programs are held 7 days / week in the summer, from early morning into the evening. Most staff will work an average of 15-20 hours per week. Mandatory training is held weekly in the summer.

Must be able to clearly communicate, as well as understand both verbal and written instructions. Performs a variety of duties and other work as required. Lifeguard, Swim Instructor and Swim Coach positions require certification in American Red Cross Lifeguard Training, including CPR/AED for Lifeguards and First Aid, and Administering Emergency Oxygen.
