

Housing Services in Contra Costa County

Are you experiencing a housing crisis?

If you are at-risk of losing your current housing or need help to move to more stable housing, then Catholic Charities might be able to help you.

We may provide help with:

- Back Rent if you have received an eviction or three-day notice
- Deposit: if you have identified a new place to live and have a Letter of Intent to Rent or if you are a Section 8 recipient you must provide a passing Proof of Inspection report
- Utility Assistance: limited to those receiving rental or deposit assistance

Who may qualify:

If you meet the above criteria, you must also be experiencing a housing crisis. For example, a loss of housing due to unemployment or another documented crisis. You must also demonstrate that you have sufficient income to support your family and housing needs beyond this assistance.

Services we may also provide:

- One-time financial assistance
- Budget review & Counseling
- Case Management
- Referrals for additional resources
